- Prepare your Apple or Windows device for the test day. This can be either a laptop or a tablet. Your device should be **fully charged with setup Bluebook application**
- If you use an iPad, make sure that the version of your iPad is **not iPadOS 17.0**. Please, update your device to iPadOS 17.1 and up, or use version 16 or earlier.
- Importantly, you must test your testing device before the test day by going to **Test Preview on Bluebook** in order to check your device's function including keyboard
- Bring your printed admission ticket or electronic admission ticket on your device.
- Show up at the registration of the test center on the test day by **7:30 a.m.**

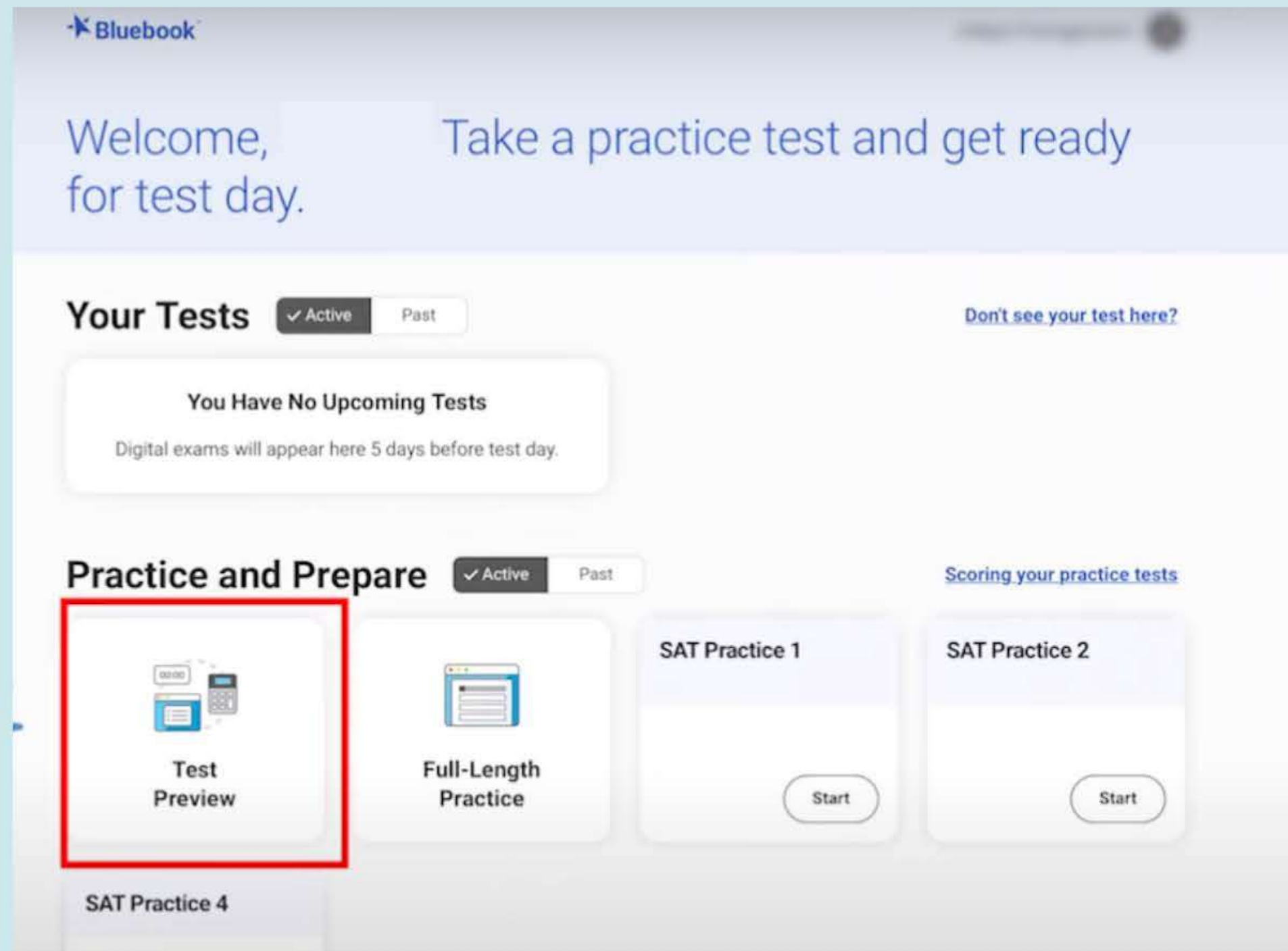
