Application Information for the 2nd Entry of Academic Year 2026 - 2027

Whereas it is expedient to open for admission to 17 majors of Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Management, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Communication Arts, Bachelor of Engineering and Bachelor of Arts and Science for the 2nd round of Academic Year 2026 - 2027. The details on application and selection process are as follows:

1. The 8 programs that are open for admission are:

- 1) Bachelor of Business Administration
 - Business Economics
 - Finance
 - International Business
 - Marketing
- 2) Bachelor of Management
 - Travel and Service Business Entrepreneurship
- 3) Bachelor of Science
 - Applied Mathematics
 - Biological Sciences
 - Chemistry
 - Computer Science
 - Food Science and Technology
 - Physics
- 4) Bachelor of Fine Arts
 - Communication Design
- 5) Bachelor of Arts
 - International Relations and Global Affairs
 - Intercultural Studies and Languages
- 6) Bachelor of Communication Arts
 - Media and Communication

- 7) Bachelor of Engineering
 - Computer Engineering
- 8) Bachelor of Arts and Science
 - Creative Technology

2. Applicants' Qualifications

2.1 Must not have serious contagious disease or socially stigmatized disease and/or any disease that will obstruct their studies.

2.2 Must have no record of serious misconduct. Must also promise to the university that they will pay attention to their studies and strictly follow the rules and regulations of the university now in force and any future regulations.

2.3 Must have never been expelled from any institution due to inappropriate behavior or any serious disciplinary offense.

2.4 Must have never been penalized for cheating or being involved in cheating on high school education or higher education institutions' admission examination.

2.5 Must not have been found to have faked or forged application documents within 2 years.

2.6 Must guarantee or have a sponsor who guarantees to cover all tuition fees and related educational expenses until graduation.

2.7 Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 or its equivalent under the following conditions:

(1) Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 in Thai system school; or

(2) Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 (Grade 12 equivalent) at an international school in Thailand with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee; or

(3) Graduated high school education from an overseas institution with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee; or

(4) Graduated from any educational program or its equivalents to high school level, domestic or international education systems with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee as determined for each academic year.

2.8 Applicants taking the GED must pass 145 score for each subject and submit the total score of at least 600 along with the most recent educational record with supporting documents.

2.9 Applicants who submit UK curriculum (Private Candidate) must have 'A' Level result in at least 3 different subjects with Grade of A - C along with the most recent educational record with supporting documents.

2.10 Applicants must have the specific qualifications according to majors which are shown on www.muic.mahidol.ac.th

3. Application Process

1) Fill out the online Application Form, available on website <https://admission.muic.io/#/login> from Monday, June 29, 2026 until Wednesday, July 8, 2026 before 4.00 pm.

2) Scan all required documents and upload on website <https://admission.muic.io/#/login> from Monday, June 29, 2026 until Wednesday, July 8, 2026 before 4.00 pm.

3) Applicants must check their application's status on website <https://admission.muic.io/#/login> after sending the required documents.

Applicants whose qualifications do not meet all requirements or who are unable to submit all required documents are not eligible to take examination. MUIC shall not refund application fee in any case.

(1) High School Certificate from Ministry of Education (Thai High School), or

(2) High School Diploma, International School in Thailand or abroad

4.7 Student's verification letter (if studying)

4.8 Original **and** electronic official score of TOEFL (iBT) or IELTS (Academic) or PTE or Duolingo English Test, with scores issued within two years of the application date (if applicable). The following minimum scores are required:

4.11 Application Fee

Applicants must submit the required documents for application listed in 4.1) to 4.11). If documents or proofs are incomplete, MUIC reserves the right not to consider applications.

Remark: In the event that any document or proof submitted for the application is found altered/fake/forged or contains false information, the applicant shall be disqualified from applying for a period of two years.

6. Examination Subjects

- 1) Examination subjects are TOEFL(ITP), Writing and Mathematics*.
- 2) Applicants who submit the original copies of English Proficiency Test (TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, Duolingo English Test) and Mathematics (ACT, SAT) are not allowed to get them back if they pass examination and register to study at MUIC or at PC.
- 3) Applicants of Communication Design, Intercultural Studies and Languages and International Relations and Global Affairs are not required to sit for Mathematics examination.

Remark:

- *1. Calculators allowed during Math Exam include;
 - Most graphing calculators
 - All scientific calculators
 - All four-function calculator
2. Examination result will be evaluated by the MUIC Admissions Committee and the MUIC Admissions Committee's judgment is final

8. Announcement of Eligible Applicants for Written Examination

MUIC will announce the list of eligible applicants for written examination and exam code on **Thursday, July 16, 2026** on website <https://admission.muic.io/#/login>

9. Examination Rules

- 1) All candidates must show their Thai ID card or passport on examination date. Otherwise, they are not allowed to take the examination.
- 2) Candidates must take examination in all subjects.
- 3) Wear a school uniform or university uniform. Jeans, t-shirt, sandals or shoes with no strap are not allowed.

4) Candidates who arrive at the examination room more than 15 minutes late will not be allowed to sit for the examination.

5) Pencil cases, papers, cameras and rulers with multiplication tables are not allowed to bring into the examination room. Candidates are allowed to bring only their ID card or passport, 2B pencils, erasers, pens, and liquid papers into the examination room.

6) Candidates are not allowed to bring mobile phones or any communication devices into the examination room. Anyone whose mobile phone rings during the examination will be asked to leave the examination room and will automatically fail the exam.

7) Candidates are not allowed to go to the restroom or leave the examination room during the examination.

8) For those who have passed the written entrance examination, they must come to the interview on the designated date and time and wear a school uniform or a formal dress.

9) For those who have passed the interview examination, they must report to MUIC on the designated date and time and wear a school or a university uniform.

Remark: Candidates must strictly follow the examination rules. If a candidate is found cheating in any way, MUIC reserves the right not to consider the examination or examination paper of such candidate in any circumstances.

10. Selection Criteria

Applicants are required to take the MUIC examination. Applicants are required to pass the examination which will be evaluated by the MUIC Admissions Committee and the MUIC Admission Committee's judgment is final. Those who pass the examination will be separated into 2 groups:

1) Applicants whose scores meet MUIC requirement are eligible for interview for entering bachelor's degree program at MUIC.

2) Applicants whose scores do not meet the requirement to be eligible for interview for entering bachelor's degree program at MUIC but their scores meet the requirement to enter PC are eligible for interview at PC.

12. Interview Examination

1) For candidates who are eligible for entering bachelor's degree program at MUIC, the interview examination will be held during **Thursday, August 20, 2026 – Monday, August 24, 2026** at Mahidol University International College.

2) For candidates who are eligible for entering PC, the interview examination will be held on **Saturday, August 22, 2026** at Mahidol University International College.

Remarks: If the eligible candidates cannot come for interview on the specified date and time, they will be considered as forfeit.

13. Announcement of Eligible Candidates for Admission/Interview

Remark:

1. Candidates do not report on the specified date and time, they will be considered as forfeit their admission.

2. Candidates must pay Admission Fee of 10,000 Baht within the specified time.

3. Admission Fee (10,000 Baht) is not refundable in any case

14. Acceptance Criteria

A. MUIC Criteria

1. Selected candidates can register for studying only if they graduated from M.6 or its equivalent.

2. Selected candidates who wait for their high school graduation results or are studying cannot begin their studies in that trimester. Moreover, they must submit their graduation certificate within one trimester. If they fail to submit this document in the specified time, it shall be considered that they forfeit their admission and do not intend to study at MUIC.

3. Selected candidates who wait for student visa (Ed visa) cannot begin their studies in that trimester. Moreover, they must submit their visa within one trimester. If they fail to submit this document in the specified time, it shall be considered that they forfeit their admission and do not intend to study at MUIC.

4. Selected candidates who graduated from M.6 or its equivalent must begin their studies in that trimester. MUIC do not allow these selected candidates to postpone their studies in the first trimester of the first year.

B. PC Criteria

1. Candidates who have passed the examination and graduated from high school or its equivalent can register for studying at PC.

2. If selected candidates cannot begin their studies in that trimester since they are studying, they can postpone registration at PC. Moreover, they are required to pay the Admission Fee of 10,000 Baht within the specified time and must return to study at PC within 6 months. If failing to do so, they will be considered as forfeit their admission.
