



Announcement of Mahidol University International College  
on the Undergraduate Admissions and Selection Process  
International Program, Mahidol University International College  
Direct Admission System

To ensure the smooth operation of the undergraduate admission and selection process for Mahidol University International College (MUIC) under the Direct Admission System, including both the General Direct Admission Track (College Track) and the Preparation Center for Languages and Mathematics Direct Track (PC Direct Track)

By virtue of Clause 7 of the Mahidol University Regulations on Undergraduate and Associate Degree Education B.E. 2567 (2024), in the Faculty Committee of Mahidol University International College's meeting No. 1/2026 on January 14, 2026 and meeting No. 2/2026 on February 11, 2026, with the approval of the President of Mahidol University, the following criteria and procedures are hereby established for the admission and selection of undergraduate students.

Mahidol University International College hereby announces the undergraduate admissions for its various programs. The application and selection procedures are outlined as follows:

## 1. Types of Admissions

### 1.1 College Track: Divided into 2 types:

1.1.1 Thai, at home and abroad, and foreign nationals residing in Thailand;

1.1.2 Thai or foreign nationals residing abroad and never studied in Thailand (Overseas).

### 1.2 Preparation Center for Languages and Mathematics Direct Track (PC Direct Track):

Students who want to improve their English and Math skills before studying at MUIC. PC's English Program (EP) and Mathematical Foundations Program (MP) are direct pathways to MUIC. Once students have passed either program, they automatically gain conditional acceptance to study at MUIC.

## 2. Applicants' Qualifications

### 2.1 General Qualifications for both types of admissions

2.1.1 Must not have serious contagious disease or socially stigmatized disease and/or any disease that will obstruct their studies;

2.1.2 Must have no record of serious misconduct. Must also promise to the university that they will pay attention to their studies and strictly follow the rules and regulations of the university now in force and any future regulations;

2.1.3 Must have never been expelled from any institution due to inappropriate behavior or any serious disciplinary offense;

2.1.4 Must have never been penalized for cheating or being involved in cheating on high school education or higher education institutions' admission examination;

2.1.5 Must not have been found to have faked or forged application documents within 2 years;

2.1.6 Must guarantee or have a sponsor who guarantees to cover all tuition fees and related educational expenses until graduation.

### 2.2 Qualifications for College Track

#### 2.2.1 Educational Qualifications

2.2.1.1 Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 or its equivalent under the following conditions:

(1) Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 in Thai system school; or

(2) Graduated from or studying in the final term of Matthayom 6 (Grade 12 equivalent) at an international school in Thailand with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee; or

(3) Graduated high school education from an overseas institution with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee; or

(4) Graduated from any educational program or its equivalents to high school level, domestic or international education systems with the criteria set by the Ministry of Education and/or the Council of University Presidents of Thailand and/or the Admissions Committee as determined for each academic year;

2.2.1.2 Applicants taking the GED must pass 145 score for each subject and submit the total score of at least 600 with the most recent educational record with supporting documents;

2.2.1.3 Applicants who submit UK curriculum (Private Candidate) must have 'A' Level result in at least 3 different subjects with minimum Grade of C along with the most recent educational record with supporting documents.

#### 2.2.2 Specific Qualifications

Applicants must have the specific qualifications according to majors which are shown on [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th)

#### 2.3 Qualifications for PC Direct Track

2.3.1 Applicants must have qualification as shown on 2.2.1.1;

2.3.2 Applicants must submit their English and Math scores according to the PC Direct Track's criteria;

2.3.3 Applicants must have the specific qualifications according to majors which are shown on [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th)

### 3. Application Process and Required Documents

#### 3.1 Application Round

MUIC accepts applicants under the following admission categories for Undergraduate Programs in all majors:

##### 3.1.1 College Track

3.1.1.1 Application period: 4 rounds per year for Thai, at home and abroad, and foreign nationals residing in Thailand;

3.1.1.2 Application period: 3 rounds per year for Thai or foreign nationals residing abroad and never studies in Thailand (Overseas).

3.1.2 PC Direct Track shall accept applications in 4 rounds per year.

Applicants can apply for only 1 major. Please follow the application period and information which are announced on [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th).

#### 3.2 Application Process

Applicants must personally review all information contained in the admission announcement and the admission criteria established each academic year by the Admissions Committee on the website <http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th> prior to submitting their application, for their own benefit, and proceed according to the following steps:

/3.2.1 Register through...

3.2.1 Register through the online admission system at [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th) by creating personal account and password before applying. Those who have previously registered may use their existing account;

3.2.2 Complete the online application form and follow each step, including saving the information and uploading all necessary supporting documents as specified by major;

3.2.3 Check their application status through [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th). Once the application status indicates that all supporting documents have been successfully verified, applicants may proceed to pay the application fee;

3.2.4 Pay the application fee through [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th). Once the application fee has been paid, applicants will not be allowed to change their selected major.

### 3.3 Required Documents

Applicants must upload all required documents as follows:

3.3.1 One recent photograph wearing a school uniform or formal attire

3.3.2 Copy of Thai ID card or passport (for non-Thai)

3.3.3 Copy of the Name/Title Change Certificate (if applicable)

3.3.4 Copy of the House Registration; or, in the case of foreign applicants, documentary proof of lawful residence in Thailand issued by the competent governmental authorities

3.3.5 Copy of the Official Transcript

3.3.6 Copy of the High School Certificate/Diploma (if graduated)

(1) High School Certificate from Ministry of Education (Thai High School), or

(2) High School Diploma, International School in Thailand or abroad

3.3.7 Student's verification letter (if studying)

3.3.8 Original **and** electronic official score of TOEFL (iBT) or IELTS (Academic) or PTE or Duolingo English Test, with scores issued within two years of the application date (if applicable). The following minimum scores are required:

TOEFL	IELTS	PTE	Duolingo English Test

Please note that effective January 21, 2026, the required TOEFL (iBT) Writing score must be equivalent to 4.5, in accordance with the new score comparison criteria.

3.3.9 Original and electronic official score of SAT (Math) or ACT (Math), with scores issued within two years of the application date (if applicable). The following minimum score are required:

Major	SAT	ACT
1. Business Administration	600	25
2. Science	600	25
3. Computer Engineering	600	25
4. Creative Technology	600	25
5. Travel and Service Business Entrepreneurship	500	18
6. Media and Communication	500	18

Please note that applicants to certain programs or majors are not required to submit SAT (Math) or ACT (Math) scores. For further details, please visit <http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th>.

3.3.10 Other documents which are required

3.3.11 Application Fee

Types of Fees	Fee (Baht)
1. Application Fee	1,500
2. ITP TOEFL Test Fee	1,200
3. Writing Test Fee	500
4. Mathematics Test Fee	500
5. Application Fee for Overseas Applicants	2,500

Please note that in the following cases, the applicant will be considered disqualified:

- (1) Applicant does not meet the required qualifications or any error which is caused by the applicant;
- (2) Applicant fails to submit or submits incomplete supporting documents required for the application; or
- (3) Applicant's documents or proof submitted for the application are found altered, forged, falsified, or contains false information, as a result, the applicant shall be disqualified from applying for a period of two years.

MUIC also reserves the right not to refund the application fee. Exceptions may be made if the applicant requests to withdraw the application due to valid and justifiable reasons.

2. Interview Examination Date	July	October	January
3. Announcement of Selected Candidates	July	October	February

## 5. Selection Criteria and Interview

### 5.1 College Track

5.1.1 Applicants must meet the required score criteria or pass the Written Examination. For more information, please visit [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th).

#### 5.1.2 Eligible candidates for interview – Divided into 2 groups:

5.1.2.1 Candidates who are eligible for the Undergraduate program interview (College Interview) must attend the interview on the date and time specified in the official announcement. The interview evaluation will be determined by the faculty representative from each program or major. Candidates who fail to attend the interview will be considered as having forfeited their eligibility. MUIC reserves the right not to refund the application fee in accordance with Clause 3.3.11;

5.1.2.2 Candidates who are eligible for the Preparation Center for Languages and Mathematics (PC Interview) must attend the interview on the date and time specified in the official announcement. Candidates who fail to attend the interview will be considered as having forfeited their eligibility. MUIC reserves the right not to refund the application fee in accordance with Clause 3.3.11.

### 5.2 PC Direct Track

Applicants must meet the criteria for applying to PC Direct Track. For more information, please visit [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th)

5.3 The Admissions Committee for New Undergraduate Students of Mahidol University International College shall have the authority to determine and adjudicate the results of the selection examinations for each round. The Committee's decisions shall be final and binding, and the Dean shall sign to approve the announcement of the names of candidates selected in each round.

## 6. Admissions Confirmation

### 6.1 Successful candidates are categorized into 2 groups:

6.1.1 Candidates who are eligible for Undergraduate admissions must confirm their results and pay the Admissions Fee of 10,000 Baht through [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th) within the specified date and time. Failure to do so will be considered a forfeiture of the offer and cannot be reinstated;

6.1.2 Candidates who are eligible to attend the foundational training program at Preparation Center for Languages and Mathematics must follow the instructions which are posted on [www.muic.mahidol.ac.th](http://www.muic.mahidol.ac.th)

/6.2 Candidates...

6.2 Candidates whose high school graduation results are pending must follow these instructions:

6.2.1 Confirm their results according to clause 6.1 to retain their status; and

6.2.2 Submit the required documents no later than 1 trimester from the date the interview results are announced. Failure to submit within the deadline will result in forfeiture and cannot be reinstated.

6.3 Candidates who are waiting for student visa (Ed visa) must follow these instructions:

6.3.1 Confirm their results according to clause 6.1 to retain their status; and

6.3.2 Submit the proof of student visa approval no later than 1 trimester from the date the interview results are announced. Failure to submit within the deadline will result in forfeiture and cannot be reinstated.

Please note that MUIC reserves the right not to refund the Admissions Fee under any circumstances.

## 7. Eligibility for Admissions

If MUIC determines that the admitted students have not completed the required education or does not meet the qualifications specified by the programs or majors, MUIC will deem the admission null and void and reserves the right to withhold refunds of the application fee, the admission fee (Admission Fee), and any tuition fees under any circumstances.

Furthermore, if any documents or proof submitted for the application are found altered, forged, falsified, or contains false information, the applicant's admission to MUIC (if already granted) will be revoked, the applicant shall be disqualified from applying for a period of two years, and MUIC may pursue legal action.
